




**Bishop's Teaching Event - Growing confidence in the word of God in Ludlow -10<sup>th</sup> February.**

Our next event is a talk entitled **Genetics - Worries, Nonsense and Hopes** by Dr Vanja Crew, one of the country's leading geneticists, in St John's Methodist Church Hall, St Owen Street, Hereford, at 2.30 pm on Wednesday 28th February. All are welcome.

There is a CPAS training event coming up on 6<sup>th</sup> March 10am-3:30pm both at the Mascall Centre in Ludlow:

We lead in uncertain times when models of missional leadership that have worked in the past feel less helpful today. What does it mean to be agile in our leadership. How can we grow in this approach? Adopting insights from adaptive leadership thinking, this event offers space for clergy to reflect on their own approach, as well as exploring practical ways to lead well when it isn't always easy to know where you are going.



This Lent, join the community of Hereford Cathedral as they perform the Hereford Passion.

Sharing the story of Jesus' final days, the production will use words, music, action to tell the events of that fateful week against the stunning architecture of the cathedral nave. The production will be directed by the Revd Canon Chancellor James Pacey who has directed five previous performances in Newark, Cambridge, Nottingham and in the cathedral church of Southwell Minster.

The performance will begin at 7.30pm (doors open at 7pm) and tickets cost £8 per adult and £6 per child. Please note that there is no interval in this production.
